New Church plant in Kasambya

Our 10th church was planted in the village of Kasambya this spring. God has already provided a plot of land in the center of the village. There are 188 homes and over 900 residents in this village.



The Kasambya House of Prayer church began with an evangelistic outreach in June of this year.

Nearby Bulamu House of Prayer took the lead in planting this new church and is providing leadership training and oversight as they grow.



The chairman of the village who is a Muslim man is very supportive of the work and helped us to find a plot of land in the village center. He asked us to visit his home and pray for his family. We asked Jesus to reveal Himself to this man and his household.

Conferences

Frontier Force Bible Institute continues to be an effective tool for training our pastors and leaders to "Equip the Saints For the Work of Ministry" Ephesians 4:12. We also attended a marriage conference on the shores of Lake Victoria.

We visited Kanalaki Village on September 17 to dedicate the new church building. In Africa, a church with land and a building is viewed by the community as a commitment to a permanent presence in the village.
